XBOWLING DUO

Xbowling Prosek DUO is an attractively renovated 12-lane bowling center, which follows the tradition of one of the first bowling centers in the Czech Republic, Sportcentrum Duo, which was opened to the public in 1995. The bowling center has 12 Brunswick pro bowling lanes and is the largest bowling center in Prague.

XBOWLING ŽIŽKOV

Bowling Zizkov is a modern bowling arena (opened in 2013) providing 6 lanes QubicaAMF of excellent quality and regularly treated. The whole arena is air-conditioned and completely non-smoking.

A restaurant serving lunch and a never-ending supply of beer is provided in both centres.

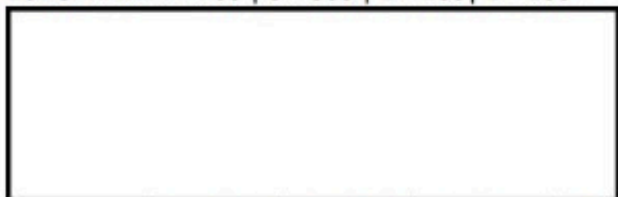
